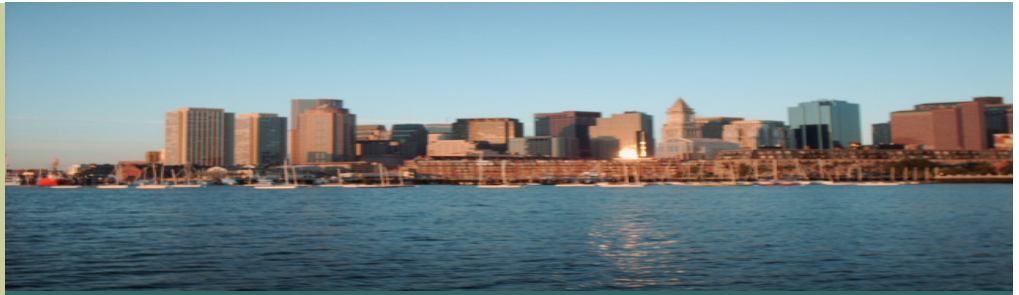

The \$787B Recovery Act was signed into law by the President on February 17<sup>th</sup> to jump-start the economy. Starting in October and each quarter thereafter, recipients of ARRA funding will report quarterly on how they have spent the Recovery Act funds that they received.

On August 17<sup>th</sup>, recipients began to register at [www.FederalReporting.gov](http://www.FederalReporting.gov), the first step in reporting expenditures of recovery funds as required by the Recovery Act.
